

## Before you apply

### Program objectives and overview

#### The Forest Sector Fund – Building Log Incentive:

- Encourages timber harvesters to diversify their businesses and support local log home and cabin builders by supplying them with building logs.
- The Forest Sector Fund – Building Log Incentive is currently approved for a two-year lifespan.

**Application period year 1 (2025-26):** November 4, 2025, to March 20, 2026

**Application period year 2 (2026-27):** April 1, 2026, to March 19, 2027

### Eligibility

- Eligible recipients for the Forest Sector Fund must be Yukon-registered commercial timber harvesters.
- Eligible recipients must have a Yukon Corporate Registry number that is valid for the application period.
- Commercial harvesters must be up to date with reporting requirements under licences and permits at the date of application.
- Commercial harvesters will not be eligible for the Forest Sector Fund, if they have not paid all fees required under the *Forest Resources Act*.
- Eligible recipients are those supplying building logs to log home and cabin builders.
- Building logs are those intended to form the walls or structure of a building.
- The following is not eligible for the Building Log Incentive:
  - Logs imported into Yukon from other jurisdictions.
- Proof of purchase receipts including the name and contact information of the purchaser are required. The Forest Management Branch may contact purchasers to verify transaction(s).
- If you are a Yukon commercial timber harvester who harvests building logs to supply your own log home or cabin building business contact the Forest Management Branch for further details on how to apply.

### Annual available funding

An eligible recipient of the Building Log incentive may not receive more than \$10 per cubic metre and more than \$2,000 for harvest categories 1 to 3 and \$5,000 for harvest categories 4 to 5 in one year.

### Distribution of funds

- Money paid for the Building Log Incentive is based on the volume of building logs sold.
- When the amounts payable under the Building Log Incentive exceed the maximum allocated funding available for this initiative, applications will no longer be accepted.
- All applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis.
