
## Who can be on your child's school-based team?



Navigating a child's unique learning journey can be stressful and challenging. School-based teams bring everyone together to combine strengths to support your child's success.

The school-based team meets to look at your child's work and talk about their progress and supports that could help. You are an important member of this team. The team creates a personalized learning plan that is shared with your child's teachers and your child in an age-appropriate way.

Work with Student

Your child's teachers use the strategies discussed during the team meeting and keep an eye on any changes in your child's learning. The school-based team will share updates with you and your child as needed, or requested, and might have more team meetings to review and adjust strategies.

The new strategies are then implemented and monitored. The school-based team will track progress and share updates with parents or guardians and your child as needed or requested. More team meetings may occur to review and adjust strategies to

keep them relevant.

If various strategies have been tried and more information is still needed, the school-based team will discuss whether a formal assessment is needed. A formal assessment should not be undertaken if not necessary. Formal assessments can be lengthy and stressful for families and children. Once results are received, there will be a conversation to talk about next steps.

Support Services

If concerns remain after trying the strategies in the personalized learning plan, the school-based team will begin the process for a consult with Student Support Services staff to get more details and insights. You will sign a consent for referral form at this time.

Support Services

The Student Support Services team will attend meetings and provide specialized guidance and further interventions to support your child's learning needs.

You or a teacher notices that your child needs extra support to learn. The teacher starts collecting and reviewing information from your child's work samples and past reports. They may also chat with you, past teachers and counsellors. You will be asked to sign a school-based team referral
