Completely fill in the following information as accurately as possible. This is an important part of the oil and gas licencing process pursuant to section 19 of the *Gas Processing Plant Regulation*.

INSTRUCTIONS

Submit an application for every construction authorization required. An application may be submitted by mail or email.

All sections must be completed.

Section 1: Date of application

Section 2: Construction start date

Applications must be submitted 14 days before the commencement of construction.

Section 3: Licensee

Indicate the legal name and the identification code pursuant to section 5 of the *Oil and Gas Licence Administration Regulations*.

Section 4. Licence

A gas processing plant or liquefied natural gas facility licence must be in effect before a construction authorization will be considered. Identify the licence and amendment number, and the facility name.

Section 5. Name of agent

If an agent is submitting the application for the licensee indicate the agent's legal name, otherwise leave this area blank.

Section 6. Contact information

Indicate an address where the licensee can be contacted. If an agent is acting for the licensee, indicate contact information for the agent.

Section 7. Description of project

Enter a short description of the project for reference.

Section 8. Drawings and specifications

Include a list of attachments with the required information in this category. Applicants are responsible for the submission of thorough and complete information to describe the scope of the entire licensed project that they intend to construct within the construction period defined in the licence. Documents must be authorized by a professional engineer registered with the Association of Professional Engineers of Yukon. Licence conditions and directions by the Chief Operations Officer may require applicants to submit additional information before issuance of authorization.
