

Before you apply

- This application is to seek permission to remove and use timber that is cut during exploration and mining activities.
- As a part of an exploration program or mining operation under the *Quartz Mining Act* (QMA) and the *Placer Mining Act* (PMA), a claim holder or operator may cut timber if they are authorized to do so under their mining land use permit (MLU).
- While the QMA, PMA and associated MLU allow a person to cut timber, the *Forest Resources Act* can convey the right to use that timber for purposes unrelated to exploration and mining.
- A Forest Resources Permit transfers ownership of timber and allows removal from the claim site.

- The Forest Management branch requires an estimate of the amount merchantable timber proposed for removal. A merchantable log is 2.5 meters in length, is a minimum of 12.5 cm in diameter at the butt end, 10 cm in diameter at the top end, and contains 50% sound wood. The Forest Management Branch may be able assist in estimating this volume.
