
Gonorrhea cases are on the rise in the Yukon

113 infections since Jan 1, 2024



Case counts and rates include all cases of gonorrhea (genital and extra-genital). Data is current as of September 30, 2024.


Projected case counts and rates assume that the average number of reported cases per month year to date (YTD) will remain constant throughout 2024.



So far in 2024, cases of Gonorrhea have increased by 465% since 2023

The Yukon is on track to exceed the previous 10-year record for number of gonorrhea infections in a year.

So far in 2024, 51% of cases are in men and 49% are in women





The majority of those infected are between 20 and 39 years old

Cases have been reported in people ranging from 15 to 62 years of age
